The Higher Tour has opened up new opportunities for ACTIOS to work in secondary schools and Leanne is currently in dialogue with the schools about how to take this forward, including a possible mentoring programme at Longsands Academy.

Leanne attended a Scripture Union Conference in January meeting with other SU Schools' Workers to exchange information and ideas and to pray for and encourage each other.
